## **Questions & Answers**

#### Q: What is the "Experience Fee"?

A: The Experience Fee will include the following: a yearbook for every student; testing prices (DELE/DELF); classroom supplies and materials for Early School and Lower School; school provided snacks for Early Childhood, field trips and textbooks. The Middle School Experience fee includes field trips, textbooks, and the Middle School overnight retreat.

Note: The 'Experience Fee' does not include PK1 and PK2 diapers, wipes, or bedding for nap time. The Middle School 'Experience Fee' does not include individual student classroom supplies.

## Q: What is the Parent Association Staff Appreciation Fund Fee?

A: The mission of the ISA-PA is to build a welcoming community among families, students, administration, and faculty. They do this by sponsoring social, educational, fundraising and community service activities throughout the school year. Based on feedback from our community, last year we opted to include this fee as part of tuition payment plans. The money collected from this fee goes into a staff appreciation fund and toward supporting other PA sponsored activities throughout the year. This fee is \$75 per student or \$150 per family.

### Q: What is the Building Capital Fee?

A: For newly enrolling families, there will be a \$500 Building Capital Fee. This is a one time fee that is paid in your family's first year with ISA. If a family already has one child enrolled at the International School of Arizona and is enrolling a younger sibling, they will not be subject to this fee. This fee is set aside in a Capital Improvement fund that will be used in the future to support building and facility improvement projects.
